REMEMBER: CLOCKS GO **FORWARD ONE HOUR** THIS WEEKEND

Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

As Mary made her way to the tomb 'very early on the first day of the week and still dark...', it must have been dark indeed. Apart from the physical darkness that surrounded her, Mary was experiencing the inner darkness of sorrow and the terrible pain of grief. She felt not only the pain of loss for her friend Jesus, but the loss of all the hopes and dreams that he had spoken about. Now it seemed pie in the sky - she had watched him suffer and die the shameful death of a criminal, abandoned and alone. It was indeed very dark. All of us have our moments of darkness - times when we feel our lives are falling apart, moments of disappointment, feelings of depression or bewilderment. Life can bring us into the valley of tears.
