Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

We might be able to relate to St Mark's account of the panic which overwhelmed the men in the boat when the storm blew up and the waves began to swamp them. There may have been occasions when we too felt paralysed by fear and crushed with terror because the tides of life had turned against us, and we felt powerless to do anything about the situation. To the disciples' astonishment "Jesus was in the stern, his head on the cushion asleep". In times of turmoil, we too may have felt totally abandoned, adrift in a storm where even Jesus appeared to be asleep. Like the people in the boat, we too may have cried out, "Master, do you not care? We are going down!"

However, we take heart from today's gospel when we realise that Jesus is always with us, and he is the one who can rebuke the storm and restore peace. We are told, "the wind dropped, and all was calm again". As we follow the Lord into the unknown, we pray for greater maturity of faith and deeper trust in his plan. For that reason, I like the following reflection which I offer as a blessing to you:

"May the peace of Christ go with you wherever he may send you. May he guide you through the wilderness, protect you through the storm. May he bring you home rejoicing at the wonders he has shown you. May he bring you home rejoicing!"
