# DAY OF PRAYER AND REFLECTION FOR GAZA ON SUNDAY 24 AUGUST

Archbishop Eamon Martin has issued a letter to all Parishes requesting us to give make Sunday a day of prayer for Gaza. The full letter may be read on our Parish website but below are two extracts from it:

"Ten weeks ago the Catholic Bishops of Ireland dedicated the month of June as a special time of prayer for peace and for solidarity with the suffering people of Gaza. This weekend I call on all parishes to once more set aside Sunday, 24th August, as a day of prayer and reflection for Gaza and for a renewed commitment by the international community for a just and lasting peace in the Middle East...."

- Spend time before the Blessed Sacrament;
- Pray the Rosary;

# KNOW YOUR CREDIT UNION - Interest Rebate

The Credit Union is a non-profit making organisation. This means that, after paying for the day-to-day running of the Credit Union and setting aside money in the General Reserve as required by the Financial Conduct Authority, any funds which are left over are returned to the members either through dividend on savings or through an interest rebate for those members who are paying interest on a loan.

Last year (2023/24) the interest rebate was set at 25%. This meant that, for example, anyone who had paid £1,000 interest on a loan over the year, £250 was returned to them. The money was lodged to their shares and could be taken out if so desired.

This really means that the interest rate quoted when taking out the loan, in real terms, became quite a bit less.

And please note......

......previously, application for membership of our Credit Union was open to all who lived and/or worked in the Parish of Kildress. It has now been extended to anyone who lives and/or works within a 10 mile radius of the Credit Union Office.
