Twenty-Sixth Sunday In Ordinary Time



Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

Today's first reading from the Prophet Amos and the gospel parable of Jesus are both concerned with the age-old gap between rich and poor, between those who are self-indulgent and those who are exploited. But the readings are also concerned with the terrible consequences of not being open to God's Word, which is always a word of challenge and consolation. The rich man was obviously a believer; he was familiar with the scriptures, but the message had not entered his heart. He was as wounded by his riches as the poor man, Lazarus, was wounded by his poverty.

On this World Day of Migrants and Refugees we think of all those forced to flee from their families and homelands and those who make dangerous journeys by land and sea in the hope of making a better life. We pray that they receive a warm welcome and generous support. We pray also for political leaders that they will make every effort to end the conflict and strife that cause such mass migration in the first place.

In his message for the 2025 observance, Pope Leo states that migrants and refugees embody hope and resilience and he urges the Church to remain committed to supporting them amid global challenges such as war, injustice and climate change.

May the words of Jesus in that other great parable of the Last Judgement always find an echo in our hearts:

"I was a stranger, and you welcomed me".
