Twenty-Seventh Sunday In Ordinary Time



Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

The request for more faith and the ability to endure suffering is a common theme throughout the Bible and very evident in today's readings.

In the first reading the prophet Habakkuk is complaining to God in desperation about the predicament of his people, who are being oppressed and suffering dreadfully. He accuses the Lord of abandoning his flock and having turned a deaf ear to his prayers of anguish. God, however, reassures Habakkuk that the answer will come and he asks him to be patient: "...if it comes slowly, wait, for come it will, without fail". What does this say to me?

In the second reading Paul is advising Timothy "to fan into a flame the gift of faith" that he has received from God with the laying on of hands. He reminds him that he has been "trusted to look after something precious" and he should guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit. What does this say to me?

In the Gospel Jesus is challenging the apostles that the smallest level of faith can do extraordinary things. "Were your faith the size of a mustard seed...."

Like the apostles, we too ask the Lord "for an increase in faith" and pray that we can "fan into a flame the gift that God gave us".

In the words of a spiritual writer, "May we realise that faith is knowing without seeing, believing without fully understanding, and trusting without hearing the One who is ever faithful."

And at the end of the day may we be able to say, "We are merely servants: we have done no more than our duty".
